When chemists in the 1800s first discovered that meteorites carry organic matter, they lacked the technology to analyze it. It wasn't until the 1950s that this matter was recognized as biological amino acids—the building blocks of life. Now students and faculty at LVC will try to find out how amino acids could be formed in the deep space environment, thanks to a grant from Research Corporation, a foundation for the advancement of science. #### LVC GRADUATES NEARLY 400 STUDENT AND HONORS AWARD WINNERS

Lebanon Valley College awarded diplomas May 10 to the largest class in the history of the College. Three hundred ninety-two graduates received their degrees on Rohland Field. In addition to some 350 seniors, there were 23 masters' degree students in business and 14 masters' degree students in science education. Nine students earned doctorates in physical therapy. Jeanne Donlevy Arnold of Lebanon was awarded a doctor of humane letters, the highest academic award given by LVC. She is well known local philanthropist and community volunteer.
