#### LVC GRADUATES 429 STUDENTS AT 141ST COMMENCEMENT; COLLEGE HONORS AWARD WINNERS

LVC awarded diplomas May 15 to 429 graduates, who received their degrees on the Academic Quad for the first time in years. The ceremonies had been held on the Athletic Quad the previous several years but had historically been held on the Academic Quad. An additional 70 December 2009 graduates also were invited to participate in Commencement. In addition to the seniors, 51 students collected masters' degrees in either business, music education, or science education.
