STUDENTS DONATE MORE THAN \$387,000 WORTH OF COMMUNITY SERVICE

LVC students completed 20,622 hours of community service during the 2006–2007 academic year, equal to \$387,074.94 worth of service, mostly for the greater Lebanon community, but also for Billingsville, Va., as part of the Appalachia Service Project and for the New Orleans area for Hurricane Katrina Relief.
