**DR. HOWARD ANTHONY "TONY" NEIDIG '43, H'04 DIES, A DISTINGUISHED
PROFESSOR EMERITUS OF CHEMISTRY**

Dr. Howard Anthony "Tony" Neidig '43, H'04, a professor *emeritus* of chemistry at Lebanon Valley College, who 60 years ago at LVC established the first joint undergraduate student-faculty research program in the country, died on Saturday, Jan. 19. Neidig, who had a distinguished career at the College and won national recognition for his work, saw the research program he started continue to thrive at Lebanon Valley College and the Chemistry Department he led for 34 years become a national leader in undergraduate science education.
