



Do we own the journal?

Bishop Library owns or has access to over 26,000 journals in print, microform or electronic format.

Use Journal Finder to locate full-text journal titles or journal titles physically owned by LVC. Journal Finder may be accessed on the library's homepage.

Type the title of the journal you're looking for in the search box, and Journal Finder will provide a listing of journals that will look like this entry:

Physical therapy (0031-9023)

from 1970 to present in [Bishop Library Print Journal Collection](#)

from 01/01/2000 to present in [Academic Search Premier](#), [CINAHL Plus with Full Text](#) and [Health Source: Nursing/Academic Edition](#)

The journal *Physical Therapy* is available from 1970 to the present in Bishop Library. Clicking on the Bishop Library Print Journal Collection link will take you into the catalog, where you'll be provided with the call number and location of the print journals.

The full-text of *Physical Therapy* is also available from 2000 to the present in three databases: Academic Search Premier, CINAHL, and HealthSource. Clicking on one of the database links will take you to the full-text of the journal or will drop you into the database search box, where you'll need to do a journal title search to locate it.
