

Multicultural Fellowship Requirements 2009-2010

The Multicultural Fellowship program format will consist of: individual activities with the newly established Multicultural Mentors, luncheons at the beginning and end of each semester, semester meetings with OMA, and the following 15 experiential learning competencies:

Career Exploration (2)
Leadership Development (5)

Civic Engagement (2)
Service Learning (2)

Financial Management (2)
Wellness (2)

Students will complete the above experiential learning competencies both as volunteers and participants. Additionally, students will be required to write a paragraph (3-4 sentences) about their experience. This information will be collected for anecdotal data/assessment purposes as well as future OMA-sponsored leadership and recognition programs and initiatives. Students with unique circumstances or studying abroad will meet with OMA to devise an alternative schedule of competencies for the semester.

Note: Competencies can be changed from year to year based on emerging trends, institutional and/or divisional goals and objectives (e.g. strategic planning, revised mission, new leadership, etc.), or other factors. Also note that specific competencies must be approved by OMA.
