APPLICATION DEPOSIT: <i>When Paid:</i> When you submit your application by March 15. <i>How Paid:</i> Paid by you with a check, cash or credit card. FEES: LVC semester fees from 2008-09: \$347.50.	
HOUSING: LVC semester room charges for 2008-09: \$1895.	
BOARD: Students prepare own meals. Approximate cost is \$1200 for the semester.
