

## Budget Sheet for Philadelphia Internship program

Item	Cost
<b>APPLICATION DEPOSIT:</b> <i>When Paid:</i> When you submit your application by Oct. 15 for spring programs, March 15 for fall programs. <i>How Paid:</i> Paid by you with a check, cash or credit card. The application fee counts toward your total program deposit of \$500 – once you have paid the application fee, you will owe the remaining \$475 of the program deposit.	<b>\$25.00</b>
<b>PROGRAM DEPOSIT:</b> <i>When Paid:</i> March 15 for fall and October 15 for spring. <i>How Paid:</i> Paid by you with a check, credit card or cash. A credit for \$500 will appear on your study abroad semester bill from LVC.	<b>\$475.00</b>
<b>TUITION:</b> LVC semester tuition charges for 2008-09: \$14,322 less scholarships and grants. <b>**Maximum of 33% tuition reduction is implemented for this program**</b>	
<b>FEES:</b> LVC semester fees from 2008-09: \$297.50.	
<b>RENT:</b> Paid directly by the student to landlord. \$350 - \$700 per month; Average is \$450 per month. *Nearly all realtors will require at least first and last month's rent and a security deposit upon lease signing. This deposit is usually equal to one month's rent divided by the number of roommates. The figures above do not include this security deposit, nor do they include utility or telephone deposits, all of which are refunded at the end of the semester - provided no damage or additional charges have been incurred.	
<b>BOARD:</b> Students prepare own meals. Average cost is \$300 per month for groceries and dining out.	
<b>STUDENT SERVICES:</b> All advising, pre-departure and re-entry orientation, and administrative support while you are abroad are included.	<b>Included</b>
<b>PERSONAL EXPENSES:</b> <i>Amount:</i> Varies based on personal spending habits and your financial situation. On average: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Book/activity fee: about \$400</li> <li>2. Utilities in apartment: \$100 per month</li> <li>3. Furniture rental/purchase: \$70 per month</li> <li>4. Transportation: \$70 per month</li> <li>5. Entertainment: \$200 per month</li> <li>6. Miscellaneous: \$100 per month</li> </ol> <i>How Paid:</i> You need to take money with you to cover your personal expenses.
